### **Yoga Class FREE**

Each day our resident yoga instructor will take you through the movements of traditional yoga methodology. Located in the Dragonfly Sanctuary, this yoga class will truly inspire you to relax & enjoy Eco Beach for what it truly is. The class is designed for first timers to experienced yoga enthusiasts & no bookings are required. See the Experience Desk for times.

### **Eco Beach Sustainability Tour FREE**

Please meet at The Experience Desk daily for a tour of our amazing retreat. Discover our vegetable gardens, accommodation & Hybrid power system. Gain an insight into the principles of sustainable development that we have introduced onsite. Please check the blackboard for times.

### **Eco Beach Sunset Drinks FREE**

(drinks charged on consumption)

Please join us at the south end of the beach for an ice cold beverage & share your stories. Beverages sold on consumption & charged to your room. Feel free to pre-order a plate from our snack menu & we will take it down ready for you. Please check the activities board for times.

### **Self Guided Bush Walk FREE**

Take the 4km journey through the dune thickets behind the beach along the coast from Cape Villaret. Explore the habitat of a diverse range of fauna & flora. Maps are available for 'self guided' walks at The Experience Desk.

### **Eco Beach Bird Hide FREE**

This well situated bird hide is located at the entrance to the bush walk. Sign out the binoculars at The Experience Desk, then sit back & watch the Kimberley & other migratory birds in their natural habitat. Complete our bird log book housed in the hide.

### **The Caves Beach Walk FREE**

Enjoy a 7km return walk along the beach south of the resort towards Cape Villaret & explore the wonders of the Kimberley Coastline at your leisure. Stop for a swim, take a picnic lunch & enjoy! A great way to extend your beach walk, head south from the 'mini bungalows' to the cave, this is tide dependant, so please check with the Experience Desk before your departure.

### **Beach Fishing FREE**

Basic tackle kits are available from the Experience Desk if you want to cast a line in your own time. Bait is available for purchase from the bar. Just a reminder that we do promote a catch & release policy onsite.

### **Beach Picnics FREE**

(picnic baskets charged on order)

Why not grab yourself a picnic hamper & spend the day on the beach at one of the beach shelters. Hampers are available from the bar (please order the day prior) & can be collected in the morning.

### **Kite Surfing FREE**

The onshore breeze prevalent at Eco Beach is ideal for kite surfing. If you have your own gear then you are welcome to play on the shore break out the front of the retreat or alternatively jump on our beach transfer to Jack's Creek (11km away) where the sandbars will provide you with some of the best flat water kiting around.

### **Turtle Talk FREE**

(minimum 2 people)

This presentation looks at the evolution of turtles into their present form. It outlines which turtles are found in Australia, their life cycle & turtle predation. It then summarises turtle activity at Eco Beach & the rules & guidelines associated with the viewing of turtles. This talk is supported by a range of images taken locally to get you in the mood for some turtle discovery. Seasonal (October to December).

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### **Whale Talk FREE**

(minimum 2 people)

This presentation looks at the evolution of whales into their present form. It then examines humpback whales in depth - their size & how they feed, the reasons & scope of their yearly migration, mothers & calves, the reasons behind some of the activities they perform, before briefly touching on whale research & injuries. It then looks at the rules & guidelines associated with the viewing of whales. This talk is supported by an example of humpback whale song & an extensive range of images taken locally to get you in the mood for a serious whale watching experience. Seasonal (July to September).

### **Pearl Appreciation with Willie Creek Pearls FREE**

Willie Creek Pearls will provide you with tips on how best to look after pearls and an insight into the different types of pearls available on today's world market. Enjoy a sparkling wine and the lustre of the pearl.

### **Whale Watching Cruises \$120 per person**

(minimum 4 people)

This 2 - 3 hour fast boat cruise will take you right to the heart of the action. View Humpback Whales in their natural environment as they frolic with other Humpbacks & their young in the waters directly off Eco Beach. Western Australia experiences the longest annual migration of humpback whales in the world & numbers have been increasing yearly to create a very healthy population. With a 100% success record for sightings in 2010 this cruise is a must-do. Seasonal (July to September). Tide & weather dependent. NB. Your feet will get wet when boarding and disembarking the vessel.

### **Sunset Cruise \$110 per person**

(minimum 2 maximum 5 people)

Spend two hours on the water exploring the coastline of Cape Villaret. BYO alcohol (takeaways available from the bar). A cheese platter provided. Enjoy the magic as the sun sets over the Indian Ocean. NB. Your feet will get wet when boarding and disembarking the vessel.

### **Turtle Tours \$40 per person**

(minimum 2 maximum 4 people)

As we cruise the beaches for nesting turtles you can enjoy the magnificent night skies. When we are lucky enough to discover them, & check to ensure that we can approach them in a discreet manner, we are able to view them as they lay their nest. Tours are generally one to two hours but are entirely dependent upon turtle behaviour & how quickly we come across them. Seasonal (October to December).

### **Nature Tours \$45 per person**

(minimum 2 maximum 4 people)

This tour first takes us to Jack's Creek where guests are invited to explore this amazing area. We then take a slow journey home stopping to view & explain any recent turtle activity (seasonal), visit 'Hermit Crab City' & 'The Swimming Holes' when suitable. Commentary relating to the local bird & wildlife by your guide is provided. Guests can request to stop & view items of interest at any time & are invited to take their drink of choice along with them (especially for the sundowners).

### **Sea Kayaking Tour \$65 per person**

(minimum 2 maximum 6 people)

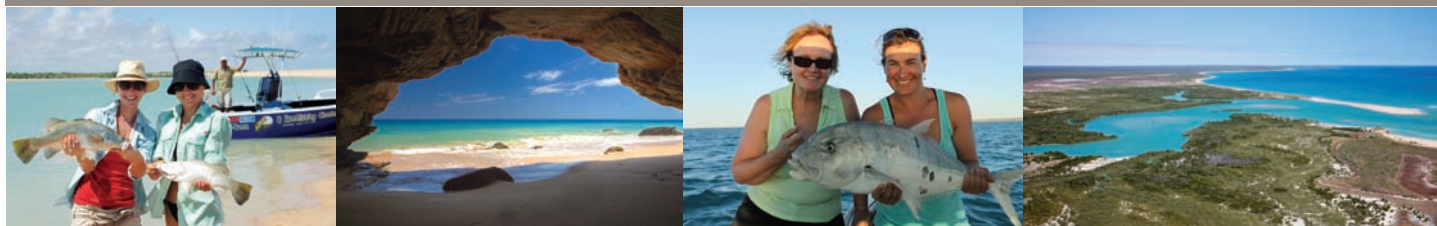
This 2-3 hour kayak tour provides you with a fun but challenging sea kayak experience, with the opportunity to view the marine life around Cape Villaret. Your guide provides you with a basic lesson in sea kayaking before you follow the coastline south to view the Caves &/or Osprey Rock from the comfort of your sit-on-top sea kayak. Also available is a 1.5 hour Mini Bungles kayak (\$50pp) or a one hour Family Fun kayak (\$45pp).

### **Mud 'n Bubbles \$40 per person**

(minimum 2)

This natural treatment is a great way to participate in a skin treatment that's not designed to be serious. Following a sand exfoliation on the high tide mark, you will then cover your skin with the healing powers of the mangrove mud from Jack's Creek. Whilst waiting for this to dry you can enjoy a glass of Australian bubbles before washing off. Mangrove mud filters, removes toxins, refreshes, moistens & softens the skin.

**Mud 'n Fun** \$30 per person  
(minimum 2)

This natural treatment is a great way to participate in a skin treatment that's not designed to be serious. **Meditation at The Caves** \$40 per person  
(minimum 2 people)

This 2-3 hour experience includes a relaxing meditation session held at The Caves on a low tide. Tide & weather dependent. Guests meet at The Experience Desk before walking the 9km round journey.

**Yoga For Fun** \$20 per adult. \$10 per child  
(minimum 2 adults)

Stretching & having fun, the less serious side of yoga with all the benefits. Great for kids & families - Fun for everyone!

**Private Yoga Class** \$100 per hour  
(maximum 2 people)

Spend an hour or two one on one with our resident yoga instructor pushing yourself to the limits, or simply focusing on a particular part of your body, mind or soul.

**Boat Fishing** \$350 per person including a light meal  
(minimum 2 maximum 5 people)

The waters off Eco Beach are abundant with Australia's hard fighting tropical sportfish. Enjoy your day on the water by either fishing Jack's Creek for the elusive Barramundi, Mangrove Jack, Cod, or Queenfish. Or light tackle the ocean for Sailfish, Spanish Mackerel, Cobia, and Giant Trevally just to name a few. Our local guide will guarantee an action packed six hours of on water action.

**Land Based Fishing** \$180 per person including a light meal (minimum 2 maximum 5 people)

Enjoy the scenic 20 minute drive to the mouth of Jack's Creek on a low tide before continuing on foot for your walk-in creek fishing experience. Fish the pools for Barramundi, Mangrove Jack & Estuary Cod or the sandbars for Salmon, Queenfish and Trevally. This four hour creek fishing experience will take you to one of Australia's most scenic fishing locations.

**Jack's Creek Experience** \$45 per person return  
(minimum 2 people)

Spend a few hours at the spectacular Jack's Creek either with a rod & reel, or just enjoying the picturesque surrounds. Tide & weather dependent.

**Guided Bush Walk** \$30 per person  
(minimum 2 people)

Take the 4km journey through the dune thickets behind the beach along the coast from Cape Villaret. Explore the habitat of a diverse range of fauna & flora as our knowledgeable guide interprets some of nature's highlights.

**Stand Up Paddle Boarding Hire (SUP)** \$20 per hour  
(maximum 5 people)

Hire these boards for an hour at a time, teach your self to balance, follow our instructions, paddle within the designated course & have FUN!

**Sea Kayak Hire (mini kayaks)** \$20 per hour  
(maximum 5 people)

Hire the small sea kayaks for a bit of fun in the marked area directly in front of the retreat. (Hire times are tide & weather dependent - please check with The Experience Desk for times & to collect your paddle). Great family fun!

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**Kimberley Degustation** \$120 per person  
(minimum 8 people)

Enjoy the company of each other & new found friends while sampling a five course meal - home grown organic produce married with unique Kimberley product accompanied by amazing Western Australian Wines. Bookings essential.

**Kimberley Taste** \$60 per person  
(minimum 4 people)

Sample local Kimberley produce such as mango products, pearl meat, Boab nut, crocodile & camel sausage accompanied by locally brewed Matso's beers & Broome's own Kanagae Estate wines & ports.

**Cooking Class** \$110 per person  
(minimum 4 people)

Meander the Eco Beach organic gardens with our chef, selecting the finest fresh produce to turn in to a foodies' delight. Spend an hour in the kitchen learning the trade secrets before enjoying the fruits of your labour with a glass of sparkling wine over lunch. Available on request only.
